
Remind your child of their qualities and skills and encourage them to ask for help in challenging situations.



Getting to School on Time

If children are left after the bell we will endeavour to contact parents/carers, however, if we are unable to contact the appropriate people we have no option but to deliver them to After School Care where a fee will be charged to the parent / carer.

Fire Safety

With the cold weather upon us, it is important that you discuss fire safety with your family. Many house fires start from unattended heaters being left on.

Make sure the whole family knows how to call 000 in an emergency, for the ambulance, police or fire brigade.

Remind your children about Stop, Drop and Roll:

If your clothes catch on fire, don't try to run away – this will only make the fire burn hotter and faster.

Instead:

- STOP immediately where you are
- DROP quickly to the ground and cover your face with your hands
- ROLL over and over to put out the flames
